Those scores will reflect what your current handicap will be. If you have turned in 5 or more rounds the system will figure a handicap for you. After checking our roster, most of you have more than 5 rounds recorded. The handicaps will be posted on the board March 1<sup>st</sup> and that will be the handicaps we will go by.
